Parents & Students,

This email is a reminder that we will have band registration on Thursday evening, July 27th at a location TBD. Registration will be available from 5:00pm-8:00pm. You may stop by at any time and the registration process should take approximately 30 minutes.

Here a few important reminders about things that you <u>MUST BRING</u> to registration:

- ALL forms (Forms are available at: http://www.sfaband.org/band-registration-forms/
 - Instrument loan agreement (only if you use a school owned instrument)
 - Tailgate restrictions form (only if you have specific dietary restrictions)
- Your black marching band shoes
 - We must see that you have them & that they're still in good condition.
 - If you've lost them or they're in bad shape, you'll need to buy a new pair.
 - If you leave them at home, you'll be asked to go back and get them, or you will be charged for a new pair.
 - All band students must have black marching band shoes.
 - New students will not have these yet.
- Your grey dri-fit uniform shirt & black dri-fit uniform shorts
 - We must see that you have them & that they're still in good condition.
 - If you've lost them or they're in bad shape, you'll need to buy them.
 - If you leave them at home, you'll be asked to go back and get them, or you will be charged for a new set.
 - All band students must have the required uniform shirt & shorts.
 - New students will not have these yet.
- Your flip folder
 - We must see that you have one.
 - If you've lost it, you'll need to buy a new one.
 - If you leave it at home, you'll be asked to go back and get it.
 - Everyone except students in the front ensemble must have one.
 - New students may or may not have a flip folder yet.
- A lyre to hold your flip folder on your instrument
 - This is required for all woodwind and brass players.
 - If you do not have one, you will need to order one at registration (prices will vary by instrument).
 - If you leave it at home, you'll be asked to go back and get it, or you will be charged for a new one.
 - New students may or may not have a lyre yet.

- Your red, 1-gallon, Coleman water bottle
 - This is required for EVERYONE in the program.
 - If you have lost yours or it broke, you will need to purchase a new one.
 - EVERYONE must have the same water bottle.
 - If you leave it at home, you'll be asked to go back and get it, or you will be charged for a new one.
 - New students will not have the appropriate water bottle yet.
 - This exact water bottle is the only one that the students should use. <u>http://www.coleman.com/teammate-beverage-cooler-</u>red/3000000731.html#start=11
- Cash, Check, or Credit Card to pay for band fees
 - All payments made by credit card will be charged an additional \$15 to cover processing fees.

We will have many spirit items with the band logo available to order at registration. All items should hopefully be available for pickup prior to the beginning of school.

Here is a basic breakdown of the fees: <u>REQUIRED</u> General Band Fee - \$215 Tailgate Fee - \$150

<u>NECESSARY FOR SOME, BUT NOT ALL</u> (All students will need these items, but may already own them)

-Flip Folder - \$10 (front ensemble does not need this)
-Extra Flip Folder Pages - \$1/each
-Lyre - \$10 (percussion will not need this)
-Coleman 1 gallon red water bottle - \$10
-Combination Lock - \$5 (only new members are charged for this)
-Marching Band Shoes - \$40
-Marching Band Uniform Shirt - \$12
-Marching Band Uniform Shorts - \$13
-FBISD School Owned Instrument Fee - \$80 (Only applies to percussion, oboe, bassoon, bass clarinet, tenor/bari saxophone, F Horn, Euphonium, and tuba)

* Brass & Woodwind students will also need to signup for OR renew their SmartMusic subscription. This is done online at home and will cost \$40.00.
